Located in Loviisa.

Organic farm since 1995. Specializing in ancient grains (emmer and spelt), other grains, berries, fruits and beers.

We believe that organic farming is not only better for the environment but also essential to producing high-quality products that meet the values of today's consumers.

Tourist attraction and manor shop since 2003. Malmgård Brewery was founded in 2009.

Malmgård Manor House

Completed 1885 in French renaissance and the main building material is uncovered brick.

The English inspired gardens were partially set up in line with drawings from 1884. Several farm buildings dating back to the late 18th century.
